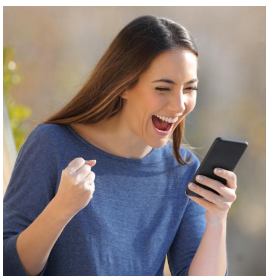

Go get it... Paralympic Games begin today!

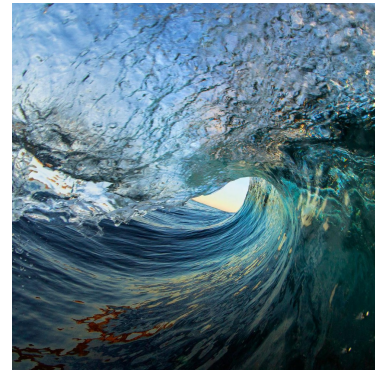

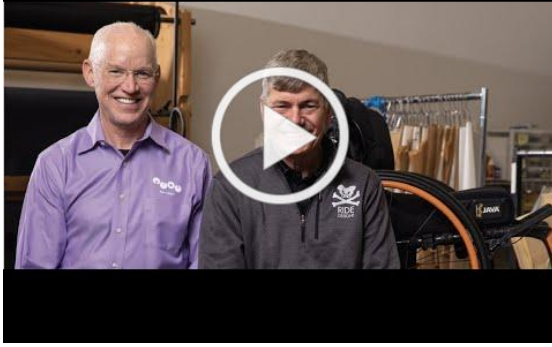
