Hosted by <u>Disabled Sports USA</u> at the Beaver Run Resort in Breckenridge, Colorado, <u>Ski Spectacular</u> is one of the nation's largest winter sports festivals for people with disabilities, with more than 800 participants each year. Programs offered during the week-long event include learn to ski and snowboard lessons, a week-long race camp,

challenge race, free clinics (in nordic skiing, biathlon, curling, and sled hockey), and social / networking events.
